
## <u>Developmental Reading Continuum</u>

Assessing students' reading proficiency involves multiple indicators such as regular observation of reading, written performance, and formal assessment. Austin ISD uses DRA (Developmental Reading Assessment) and the EDL (Evaluación del desarrollo de la lectura) for formal standardized assessment. This is the tool used to formally assess and communicate the reading proficiency of AISD students (K-2) with other tools and informal measures helping to gain a full picture of the student as a reader.



## On-Grade-Level Performance:

NOTE: These levels apply only to a student's primary language.

- ⇒ **Level 38** End of 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade
- ⇒ **Level 28** End of 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade/ Beginning of 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade
- ⇒ **Level 16** End of 1<sup>st</sup> Grade/ Beginning of 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

⇒ **Level 3** – End of Kindergarten/ Beginning of 1<sup>st</sup> Grade

Advanced Performance: For students who have achieved/ surpassed "On Grade-Level Performance," consider using "College-Readiness Performance" levels as an additional indicator while setting goals.
